

**SELF-DECLARATION JUSTIFYING TRAVEL**

G) officers and agents, howsoever called, of the European Union or international organisations, members of the diplomatic corps, administrative and technical personnel of diplomatic missions, consular officers and staff;

H) pupils and students attending a course of studies in a Member State other than the one of residence, home or abode, to which they return every day or at least once a week;

I) stay in Italy for reasons of work, health or absolute urgency, of a maximum duration of seventy-two hours (extendible by a further forty-eight hours for specific and justified needs);

A) transit through the national territory to return to the country of residence, home or abode (maximum length of stay in Italy: twenty-four hours, extendible by a further twelve hours for specific and justified needs);

B) movement from or to Member States of the European Union, Member States of the Schengen Agreement, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Andorra, Principality of Monaco, Republic of San Marino, Vatican City State, without stays in other States or territories in the fourteen days prior to entry into Italy;
